Item 13 National reporting under the Convention and its Protocols

GBIF and GEO BON welcome the harmonization effort taken by the biodiversity related conventions for effective and efficient national reporting. With many countries and scientific communities globally, GBIF and GEO BON have been working towards the interoperability of biodiversity data to monitor the progress towards Aichi Targets.

Assessing the status and trends of biodiversity is one of the key scientific and technical requirements to **effective implementation of the Strategic Plan** for Biodiversity and monitoring of progress towards Biodiversity targets. This requires **repeated biodiversity observations** that are **standardized and interoperable across time and space**, at the national level, as well as in marine, freshwater and terrestrial realms.

For the national reporting of biodiversity related conventions, GBIF and GEO BON would like to raise the **importance of spatial data** in biodiversity policy planning and decision making, and the role **well supported country nodes and biodiversity observation networks** can play in **monitoring and reporting country's commitments to the CBD**. In partnerships with countries and institutions, GBIF is committed to continue **publishing the global biodiversity data** in its online database and GEO BON is committed to the development of the **Essential Biodiversity Variables and related indicators**. GBIF and GEO BON wish to encourage the parties to **mobilize the data** produced in their countries and used for their assessments, when appropriate, into open databases.

In preparation of the post-2020 strategic development and its implementation, GBIF and GEO BON invite all parties to consider ahead of time, well-supported and solid GBIF country nodes and national Biodiversity Observation Networks to acquire and mobilize the biodiversity observation data. It is one of GBIF's and GEO BON's mandates to assist countries in this process, and we stand by, ready to support with scientific network and technical capacity to help countries build their own.
